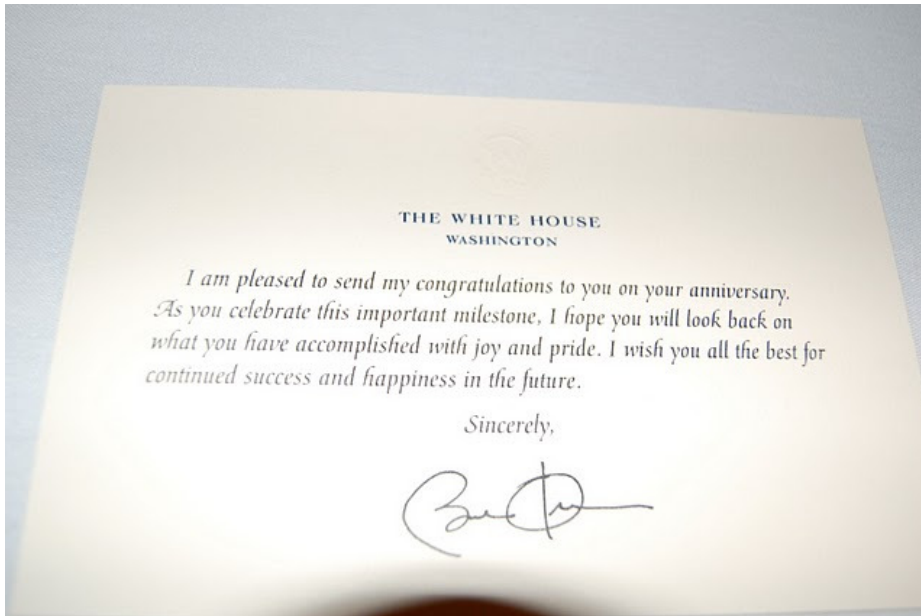
JLS Celebrates 80 Years of Community Service
